Task Group Notes

Participants on call: Charlie Curcija, Sneh Kumar, Tom Culp, Greg McKenna, Rick Wright, Stacy Germann (Staff)

Charlie Curcija – reviewed revised LC formats

Table Version of Revised LC:

Greg McKenna – questioned revised LC format would require ACE to have “shop drawings” for elevation information

Sneh Kumar – instead of “Elevation/Description” change to “Optional Description” so it is up to the ACE to insert either elevation information or product information

Charlie Curcija – suggested adding an additional “Optional Description” field in CMAST in Project for this purpose

Sneh Kumar – questioned adding back in Area Weighted Average

Tom Culp – many codes do not allow for AWA but some do;

Sneh Kumar – noted: CMAST uses AWA

Greg McKenna – should we get AWA for different categories of products or all in one

Charlie Curcija – should we have at the end of the table AWA for each product type

Charlie Curcija – possible for CMAST to calculate AWA for product type and/or material type

Sneh Kumar – suggested organizing table by product type or material type

Charlie Curcija – should we prepare to ballot these suggestions

Sneh Kumar – if the information is there we should provide it

Greg McKenna – if supplemental is AWA information then ASHRAE allows for it, then they could use it, CA could use the code compliance pages

Chart Version of Revised LC:

Greg McKenna – questioned work involved in calculating AWA per product, suggested using the chart

Charlie Curcija – there would be a chart for every product using NFRC standard sizes

Sneh Kumar – the only new information from the chart versus the table is the vision percentage, which is not very relevant

Sneh Kumar – if vision percentage is important then possibly add it to the Bid Report

Charlie Curcija – charts could be useful in Bid Report, but not LC

Greg McKenna – suggested changing wording in Supplemental to not read “not intended for use in code compliance” since some codes are leaning towards AWA; delete “For Informational Purposes Only” in the heading

Charlie Curcija – wording changed to “...are not intended for use in code compliance, unless code jurisdiction allows for area weighted performance.”; header changed to “Product at Actual Size and Area Weighted Performance Information”
