Charlie Curcija – reviewed revised LC formats

Charlie Curcija – Product Listings will now be grouped in these six non-residential products categories:

- Non-metal framing products
- Metal framing products – Curtain wall/Storefront
- Metal Framing products - Entrance Door
- Metal Framing products - Operable (e.g. all operable windows and non-entrance doors)
- Metal Framing products - Fixed (e.g. all fixed windows)
- Skylights

Charlie Curcija – questioned if CW/S can be Non-metal

Greg McKenna – Non-metal CW/S is non-metal and would fall under non-metal framing products

Greg McKenna – Does CMAST need to be updated to identify metal and non-metal framing products?

Charlie Curcija – CMAST is already capable of identifying metal and non-metal framing products based on the material code in the frame assemblies so no additional input is necessary

Joseph Holmes – questioned if the TG needed to have a “Plan B” prepared if the “code compliance” language appears to not be passing membership

Charlie Curcija – suggested the possibility of submitting 2 ballots each with its own version of the LC

Greg McKenna – stated that two ballots may inhibit the feedback necessary to move forward if there is another option

Joseph Holmes – stated that his customer feedback has said multiple times that the supplemental portion of the LC needs to identify products in each elevation and include area-weighted performance information to match what’s in the building codes

Greg McKenna – suggested staying with one ballot and, if necessary, alter the ballot language “on the fly” and motion to pass the ballot at that time, rather than submitting multiple ballots

Charlie Curcija and Joseph Holmes – agreed with Greg McKenna
