



## **CMA Labeling Task Group Conference Call Notes 12/4/2006**

Attendees: Charlie Curcija, Tom Culp, and Jessica Ferris

Charlie presented the latest draft of the 4 Label Certificates developed by the task group to date:

- a. Framing Label Certificate
- b. Glazing Label Certificate
- c. Product Label Certificate
- d. Project Label Certificate

Tom Culp provided his comments:

### Product Label Certificate:

1. Keep this to the first page. The other pages can be optional information that can be generated as this information is not necessary for code compliance.
2. Suggests providing more detail on that first page regarding the spacer, glass, and framing. This might not be necessary if additional information can be generated by the ACE.
3. The graph on the first page looks good but we might want to add a title above it to explain what the graph is. Perhaps we may want to consider using a table format as opposed to a graph format as well – just a thought. Let's slate this for further discussion with the task group at our next call.
4. There should be a reference for the frame ID.

### Framing and Glazing Certificates:

1. These should be optional certificates as opposed to required.
2. Remove "Date of Certification Authorization" - discussion held regarding components approval. Components will be considered NFRC-approved and not NFRC-certified; therefore, certification authorization dates would not apply.

### Project Certificate:

1. Should reference the ACE instead of the Inspection Agency under the certification authorization section.
2. Highlight the NFRC size.
3. We may want to consider laying out the certificate in a different format; however, all required information appears to be incorporated in the certificate.
4. Reference a Project Label Certificate Number.

5. Remove the frame code reference from the tables since it's not referenced anywhere on the project certificate. There should be a task group discussion about whether or not any of the component information should be incorporated in this certificate. Perhaps we just keep the product information only and not the component info.
