These changes will be published immediately and implemented when a test lab is NFRC accredited to test U-Factor for insulation @ ceiling and insulation @ roof. TDD simulations will not be used after that point, and a retest of existing products in the database will be within two years of that date. Motion passes 8-0-12.
