Meeting was called to order, anti-trust reminders provided, note taker assigned.

Mike Cienian explained the reason for the meeting was to share draft Ballot language for both the 100A and 200A ballots, with the intent that the ballots be submitted to NFRC staff by the end of the day for inclusion in the Summer Virtual meeting ballot documents.

Mike provided a brief overview of key changes in the 100A document, including:

- Ballot descriptions would be updated by staff
- clarification of description of the Product Line variables in section 2
- inclusion of definitions (as previously added to the NFRC 600 Glossary) in section 3
- clarification of Validation in Section 4
- inclusion of Reference Skylights in table 5.2.2

John Lewis noted the he would need the redline version of the documents.

It was pointed out that section number 2.2.1 was used for 2 different sections.

Discussion ensued on whether Vertical and Horizontal slat products should be considered as different product lines. Language was updated to reflect this in section 2.

Discussion for the Flat Panel Attachment Glazed section resulted in a more appropriate description of the types of materials and coatings.

It was suggested to include a definition of “blinds” in Section 3, Tom merker was to draft a definition so it could be included with the ballot submission.

The group reviewed the Validation language of section 4.2.4, adopted directly from NFRC 100.

It was noted that the Base Case Windows Work Group had completed the table of Reference Windows for Skylights, and that would be included in the document.

The reference windows that were approved at the Spring 2010 meeting were purposely left out of the current ballot document as they are not being balloted this time.

The Group then reviewed similar updates to the 200A document.

The scope section 2 was updated to include translucency, solar absorptance and openness factor as individual product differentiators. A reference of an appropriate standard for measuring openness factor needs to be included in the document.

Validation of SHGC is addressed in section 4.7

The Glazed/Storm Window Panel section of table 5.1 was identified as needing some review and clarification.

The group was recognized for its continued efforts.
