



NFRC's 2012 Member Categories and Dues Schedule

Membership in NFRC runs from January-December each year.

Membership Categories

NFRC membership is categorized by organization type. Any organization qualified for the Fenestration Industry category and another membership category will be placed in the Fenestration Industry category. Any organization qualified for both the Lab category and another membership category will be placed in the Lab category. NFRC's three basic membership categories correspond directly with the three categories established for NFRC's Board of Directors. Representatives of NFRC members are eligible to run for Board seats in the same category as their organization's membership category. NFRC membership categories are below.

Dues

All dues are paid annually and grant rights to contribute in NFRC's work to develop and administer energy-related rating and certification programs. Privileges include voting rights, one vote per organization, on issues and documents at the committee and subcommittee levels; for the NFRC board of directors; and/or to be elected to leadership positions.

Fenestration Industry

\$2,000

- **Mbr-1: Fenestration Manufacturers and Suppliers**
Organizations with significant involvement in the manufacture, sale, or distribution of fenestration products, components, or supplies to the industry.
- **Mbr-2: Fenestration Industry Organizations**
Organizations who have a significant involvement in representing the interests of or performing services for companies that manufacture, sell, or distribute fenestration products or components.
- **Mbr-3: Licensed Independent Inspection and Accreditation Agencies (IA's)**
Organizations who are NFRC-licensed independent certification and inspection agencies.
- **Mbr-4: General Contractor/Installers**
Organizations with significant involvement in building residential/commercial structures and/or installing fenestration products; or other organizations that have a significant involvement in representing the interests of those organizations.

Labs

\$2,000

- **Mbr-5: NFRC Accredited Labs**
Organizations who are NFRC accredited simulation and/or testing laboratories

General Interest

\$500

- **Mbr-6: Utilities or Energy Service Providers**
Organizations who are public or private utility or energy service providers or organizations who have significant involvement in representing the interests of those organizations.
- **Mbr-7: Architect, Specifier or Design Professionals**
Organizations who have significant involvement in the purchase or specification of manufactured fenestration products and/or systems or organizations who have a significant amount of activity representing the interests of those organizations.
- **Mbr-8: Government Agencies/Building Officials**
Local, state, or federal government agencies or building code agencies.
- **Mbr-9: Higher Education Institutions/Researchers**
Institutions or organizations of research and higher education.
- **Mbr-10: Public Interest/Consumer Associations**
Not-for-profit consumer, environmental, energy efficiency or other public interest organizations or organizations who have a significant amount of activity representing the interests of such organizations.
