CPD 2.0

Technology enhancements:

- 2.0 infrastructure is set up to improve the stability, the speed (time) when working with the CPD, and for scalability.

Lab enhancements:

- Test labs - Upload test data for validation (phase 1) and all physical testing values (phase 2).
- Simulation labs - will have more capabilities when revising and / or adding to a product line's rating values. This new feature will also assist the IA and Staff with modifying product lines when there are addenda.



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CPD 2.0

IA enhancements:

- The “validation” process will happen within the CPD environment. Coordinating and processing the validation are new processes for the IA. The intent of the coordination feature will be to help the IA when selecting a validation product. The processing feature will be a “communication” tool supporting the IA and labs with any possible validation issues.
- A printing feature that allows the IA the ability to offer their manufacturers CARs in a manner that meets their needs.



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CPD 2.0

Manufacturer enhancements:

- The manufacturer will have the ability to control their facilities and product lines information in a more productive and organized manner.
- Export product line data to a spreadsheet.

CPD 2.0

Public / Consumer enhancements:

- The search engine is revamped to allow users better search capabilities. For a novice user, the search will only require a few items to return results; while an experienced user can search using many criteria, such as the type of low-e, the amount of layers of glass, and the type of spacer or frame.
- Information from the search can be exported to a spreadsheet.
- The search also provides the ability for code officials to search specific labels.

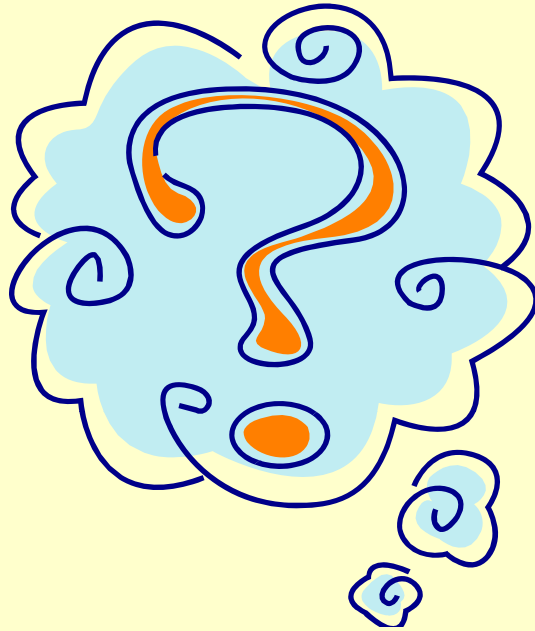
Time line
