RE: New CPD 2.0 Release for Rounding and Decimals

Hi Everyone:

This memo is to inform you that a new release has been posted to the production server dealing with rounding and decimals issue as described in the January 14, 2009 email.

- The CPD will use the values in the cell in the spreadsheet and disregard the amount of decimals displayed. This will affect any new sheets uploaded to the CPD, as well as sheets that have already been uploaded. For example, a spreadsheet uploaded on December 12, 2008 displays (two) 2 decimals in the SHGCcog column; the application will now ignore the displayed value and use the actual value in the cell: e.g., 0.32 is displayed; however, the cell value of 0.315430 will be used in calculating the rating.
- For uploadsheets that have been used to generate product lines prior to this release, NFRC will review each product line and provide support to modify any rounding errors on a case by case basis.
