Garage/Rolling Door Task Group Meeting

Monday, November 3, 2008

Chair: *Joseph R. Hetzel, P.E., DASMA*

1. Mr. Hetzel called the meeting to order at 11:40 AM. Antitrust and NFRC Meeting Guidelines reminder was given. Attendees: Joe Hetzel (DASMA), Mike Thoman (ATI – PA), Willie DuPont (Sunergy), Morgan Hanam (Enermodal), Jeff Baker (Westlab), Fred Higgins (Wayne-Dalton), Dennis Anderson (NFRC staff).
2. Dennis Anderson, NFRC staff, volunteered to take notes. Mr. Hetzel agreed to use the notes to develop minutes.
3. The agenda was reviewed and would be addressed as presented.
4. Unfinished Business
 - a. NFRC 100 and NFRC 102 ballots
 - i. Mr. Hetzel gave an overview and background behind the development of garage door and rolling door related proposed changes to NFRC 100 and NFRC 102, leading up to and including the third ballot of each. He reiterated the scope and mission of the Task Group.
 - ii. The results from the recent NFRC 100 and NFRC 102 ballots were discussed. One negative was received on each ballot, from Mr. DuPont. Comments on each negative were handled. After discussion, each comment was either withdrawn by Mr. DuPont or considered persuasive/editorial.
 - b. Work plan.
 - i. The Task Group agreed to forward the ballots, with Task Group actions, to the U-factor subcommittee for approval. The recommendation to the subcommittee would be to publish the approved revisions in NFRC 100-2004 and NFRC 102-2004 as soon as practical after the meeting.
 - ii. Should approval be issued for the ballots, Mr. Hetzel would develop a finalized set of changes, and would have Mr. DuPont review them before forwarding to NFRC for handling.
5. New Business
 - i. The subject of an RFP to review ASHRAE and DASMA research project data would be kept on the agenda for the next meeting.
 - ii. The subject of simulation and testing validation using new procedures would be kept on the agenda for the next meeting.
 - iii. The prospect of future research testing to investigate the influence of vertical jamb hardware on garage door and rolling door U-factor was discussed. This subject would be listed for the next meeting. Mr. Hetzel said he would also discuss the subject with DASMA members at the next DASMA meeting.
