1. Chair Christian Kohler called the meeting to order at 11:46 a.m.
2. John Lewis (NFRC staff) was appointed recording secretary.
3. **Reports**
 - a. **NFRC 302 TG:** Jim Larsen provided a brief report on the activities of this TG, related to the NFRC 302 ballot.
 - b. **Non-planar Simulation TG:** Chair Charlie Curcija stated no update at this time.
 - c. **Attachments Optical Properties TG:** Chair Tom Morrissey provided an update on the fabric database simulation; Teri Williamson (Newell) has been appointed chair up the cellular shade group. A second WG is looking at how to use existing standards for this matter.
 - d. **Optical Properties Priorities TG:** Chair Kohler reported (Chair Carlos McEntire not present) and stated that LBNL’s Mike Rubin continues his work.
 - e. **ISO Activity** — Jacob Jonsson provided a presentation and report on the progress of ISO / CEN activities; Chair Kohler noted that NFRC monitors the activities of this group, but no action items are current.
4. **New Business**
 - a. Raven Brick ~ Cole Woodward brought up the issue of measuring optical properties of Thermochromic glazing. C Kohler said that the measuring lab needs to ensure that the product is in a stable state when it is measured.
 - b. NFRC 302-Optical Properties Verification Program ballot. Motion to withdraw the NFRC 302 ballot and send it back to TG (Larsen/Culp) passed unanimous voice vote.
