Item 1: Recertification Exemption

The Executive Committee of NFRC's Board of Directors has approved the recommendation of the Database Committee to authorize NFRC Inspection Agencies to provide a six (6) month extension for recertification under Section 5.6 of the PCP for product lines with product line expiration dates prior to July 1, 2009.

The intent of this grant of an extension is to allow NFRC Inspection Agencies to prioritize their certification workload for new and addendum product lines by giving them more time to complete product lines requiring recertification.

The NFRC Database Committee intends to review the results of this extension every three (3) months to determine that the six (6) month authorization provides sufficient time to enable Inspection Agencies to produce CARs for recertification while continuing to provide CARs for new and addendum product lines.

Item 2: Compliance and Enforcement Issues

The NFRC Executive Committee approved the recommendation of the Database Committee that NFRC Staff develop a plan to address the unique labeling compliance and enforcement issues arising from the need for certification extensions and issuance of temporary CARs. Program participants will be advised of the plan upon its completion and approval by NFRC
