### Proposed Definitions:

**Mullion:** a horizontal or vertical structural member connecting two or more products. Mullions may be of the following types:

1. *Integral mullion:* a member that is bounded at both ends by crossing frame members and having glazing units installed at both ends
2. *Combination mullion:* a member formed by joining two or more individual fenestration products together without a mullion stiffener and it is not bounded by crossing frame members at ends.
3. *Reinforcing mullion:* a member with an added continuous mullion stiffener and joining two or more individual fenestration products along the sides of the mullion stiffener
4. *Mullion stiffener:* an additional reinforcing member used in a reinforcing mullion. Mullion stiffeners may be designed to carry the total load or may share the load with the adjacent framing members
